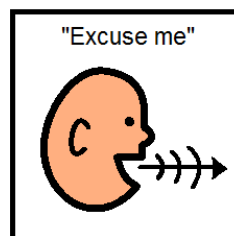
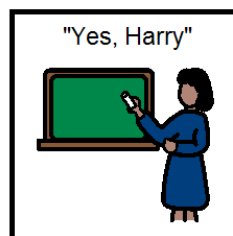
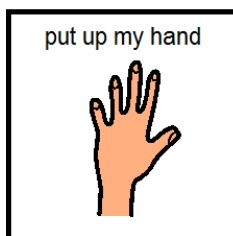
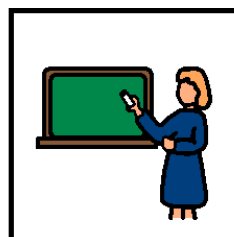
I like my teacher, Ms King. Ms King teaches me and all the children in my class.

Sometimes, Ms King is busy talking to other kids.

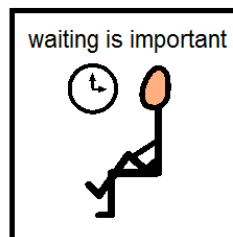
Sometimes, Ms King is busy doing her work.
